- Meet the needs of rural residents through the Richard G. Lugar Center for Rural Health, the Clay City Center for Family Medicine, the Rural Health Innovation Collaborative (RHIC) and Union Hospital Clinton.
- Provide care and public health education to those in need, including the diabetes and pre-diabetes support groups, as well as childbirth and breastfeeding classes. We also organize several free community health fairs, including the Senior Expo, Community Baby Shower, and Community Connect that allow oneon-one interaction with Union Health clinicians.
- Educate health professionals, strengthen community partnerships, foster economic development and advocate for community health improvements.
